Slovenia is completely green and it's nice to observe how God works around us and gives life. He still gives life to my family though we're often limited with time because of many responsibilities. Your prayers and God's grace keep us up, so we ask you to continue to bring us before the throne and to continue to pray for Slovenia.

There are times when I feel exhausted and overwhelmed but I repeat the verse to myself, *"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."* There have already been several good events this year and many opportunities to share the Gospel.

Just to remind you of the guy who lived with Nada and I for 6 months. In the middle of February he moved in with his parents. Pray for him. Spiritually he is growing, so we try to encourage him; at the same time pray for a job for him. Meanwhile he ran into a girl who knew him from before when he was living on drugs (he was a drug addict for 15 years) He shared his testimony with her, invited her to church and two months later she accepted Christ and by God's grace she will be baptized the last Sunday of this month. Her testimony is powerful.

We still meet in Lendava every other Monday at the Synagogue and we believe that God IS building His church there. We need your prayers and your support.



On May 11, our church celebrated Mother's Day (even though the Catholic Church here celebrates it in March) we use every opportunity to evangelize and the building was full. We had some new visitors as well as Nada's siblings with spouses who contributed to the program. Pray with us for our growing collaboration and expected merging. We also had a guest speaker from Florida, Pastor Doug Money and our daughter Mirjam translated for him.

Other than ministry we keep ourselves occupied with fixing up the house and helping individuals, either physically or spiritually. Often times Nada and I go visit our non-Christian friends and help them in their yard work or counsel them in family matters.

Arpi and Mirjam are doing really well and are active servants. They have a little baby now, Dejan, who is almost 6 months old.

Matej and Sabina will move out of the house they were renting by June 1 because the owner sold the house. They will need our help and may even move in with us. Their boys are 6 and 4; the older one is going to school this Fall.

It is a blessing for Nada and I to have our children committed to the Lord and have found spouses who faithfully follow the Lord and more so, all of them are actively involved in ministry according to their gifting.
